



ATTENTION: If you are between the ages of 19-64, a new federal law may impact your MassHealth

Starting January 2027, the federal government is making changes to MassHealth

WHO IS IMPACTED?

- most non-disabled adults ages 19-64

WHO IS NOT IMPACTED?

- people 18 and under
- people 65 and over
- people who are pregnant or postpartum
- parents of children 13 years or younger
- people living with a disability or certain health conditions
- other exemptions may apply

WHAT CHANGES ARE COMING?

To keep MassHealth coverage, you may now need to:

- work, attend school, or volunteer
- renew your coverage every 6 months

WHAT CAN I DO NOW?

Make sure MassHealth has your current cell number, mailing address, and email.
