

Sensory, IEP Clinics and Social Skills Grants

Participants for all groups MUST be DDS eligible, and under the age of 18. Parents must register within 30 days of request for funding.

Social Skills

Those who would like to enroll their child in a Social Skills Groups with a clinician may apply for funding, up to \$300.00 towards a group session. Funds will be sent directly to providers, and families would be responsible for any fees beyond \$300.00. If a provider charges less than \$300.00 the fee will be covered in total by the funding. Funding for social skills groups is limited to eligible candidates under the age of 18 who meet the criteria for participation as set by the clinician. Contact the Resource Center to secure possible funding by calling Donmarie Smith at 508-298-1609. Once your DDS status has been verified you your provider may invoice the Center for payment of \$300.00 for your child

Sensory Clinics with Mary Loughlin MS OTR/L Autism Resource Central :

Clinic will provide consultation to families in the area of Sensory Processing Dysfunction. Child and Parent will meet with Mary for four (4) I hour sessions across 4 weeks . ABA For Parents

Once again the Autism Resource Center will offer a parent training course on Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) for parents of children with Autism. ABA is a researched based approach that has been shown to be effective in the education and treatment of children.

Parents who attend will gain an understanding of the basic concepts and principles of ABA, and how these are applied in the treatment and education of children with autism. Parents will work with the instructor to identify a behavior to shape, create a program to address the behavior and implement the program Topics will include:

What is ABA?

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ABA and Effective Treatment Programs

Basic Concepts and Principles of ABA

Using ABA to teach

Using ABA to address problematic behavior

Floortime® for Parents

The Autism Resource Center, in conjunction with the Astra Foundation will once again be offering a course on **DIR®** /Floortime for Parents, starting March .

DIR® is an abbreviation for Developmental, Individual Differences, Relationship-based. DIR® is a model—a framework—for thinking about a child's complete development, from infancy into whole joyful personhood.

While DIR® can be a helpful way to think about any child's development, it is particularly useful in working with children with developmental delays.

In this course, we'll discuss the basic principles of DIR®, and learn about Floortime, a strategic, emotion-driven way of playing and interacting with a child that helps a child initiate and respond at higher and higher developmental levels. We'll also discuss the importance of understanding each child's unique sensory profile and how to incorporate this knowledge into Floortime sessions.

Participants will be provided with a copy of <u>The Child with Special Needs</u>, as part of their registration fee.

Due to popular demand this course will include the opportunity for parents to have 1:1 consultation with instructor Sarah Measures on three separate dates as the program progresses

The Course will take place at the Autism Resource Center on Wednesdays . Course Dates are as follows:
